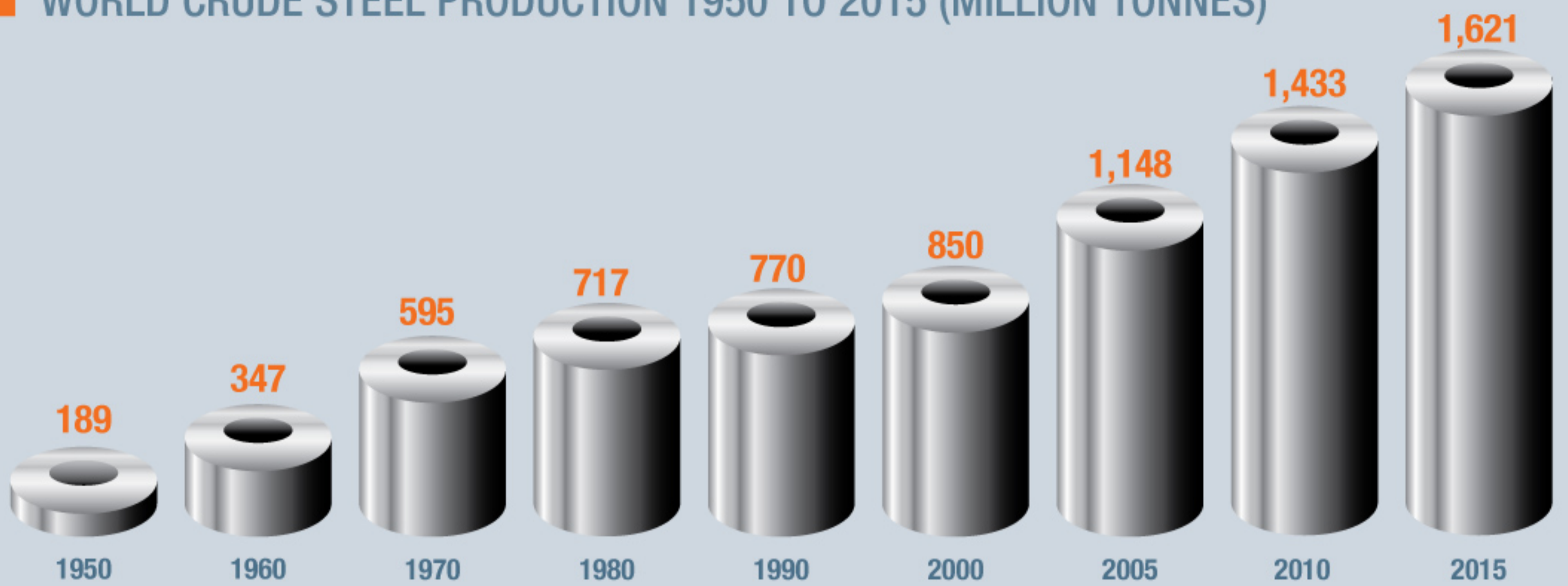


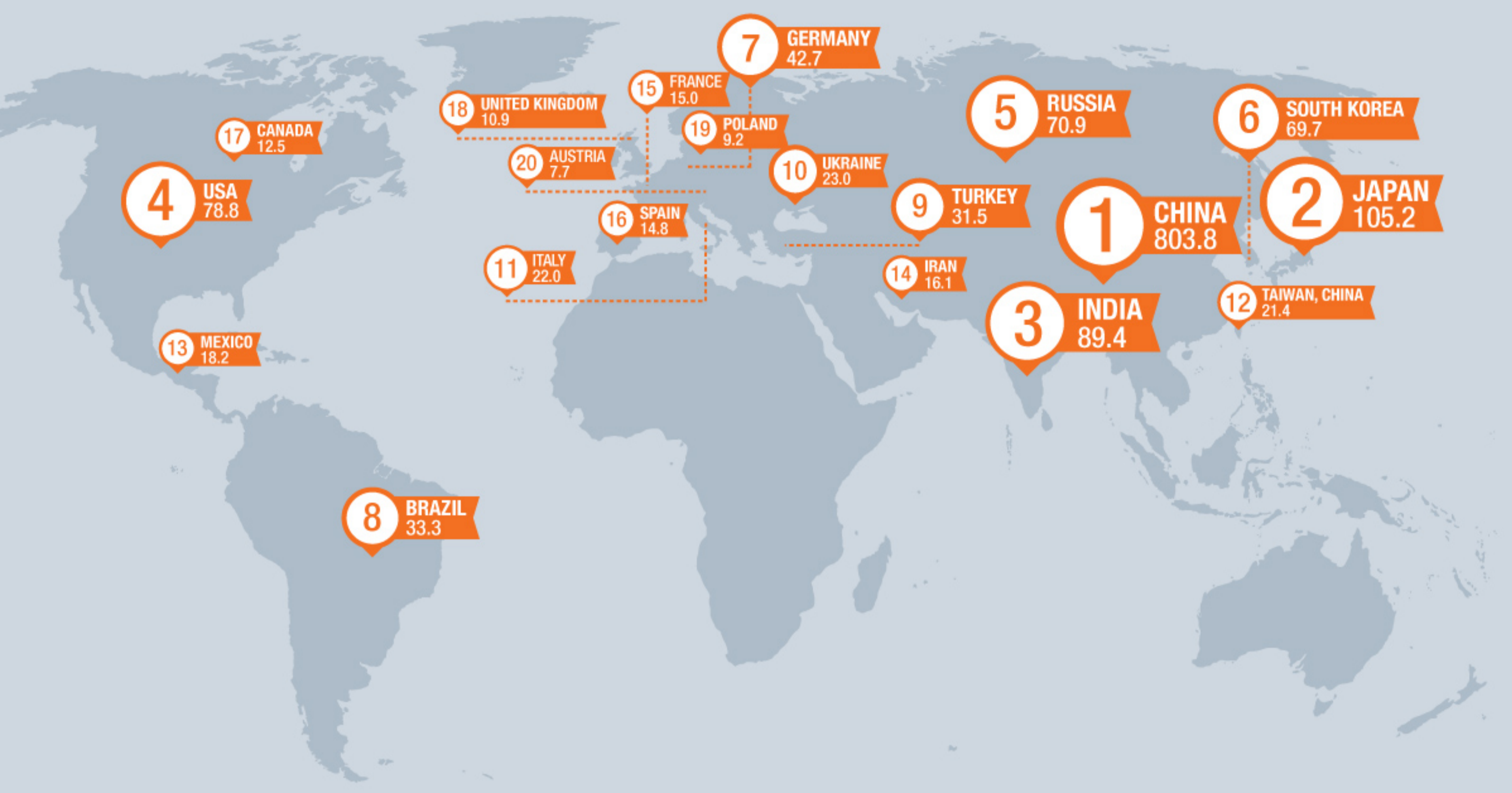
WORLD STEEL IN FIGURES 2016

WORLD CRUDE STEEL PRODUCTION 1950 TO 2015 (MILLION TONNES)



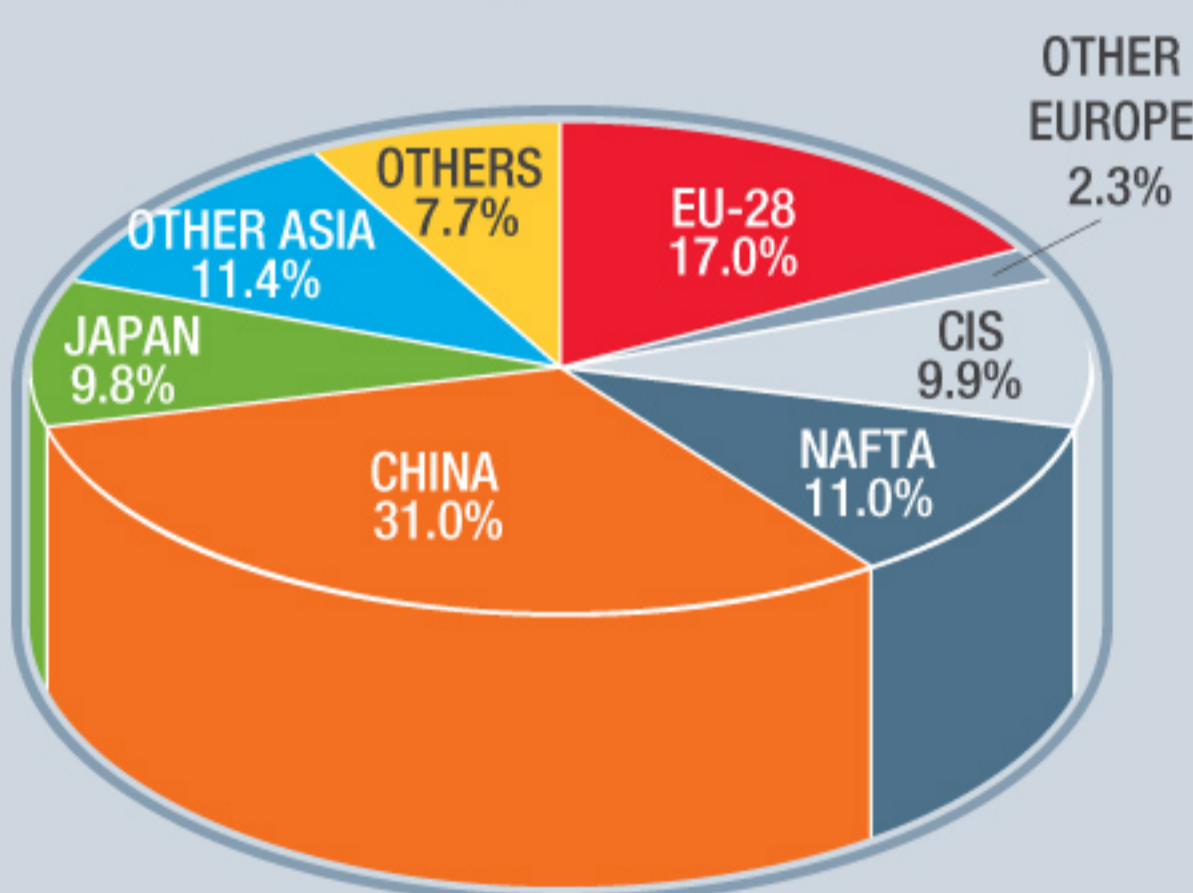
TOP 20 STEEL-PRODUCING COUNTRIES 2015 (MILLION TONNES)

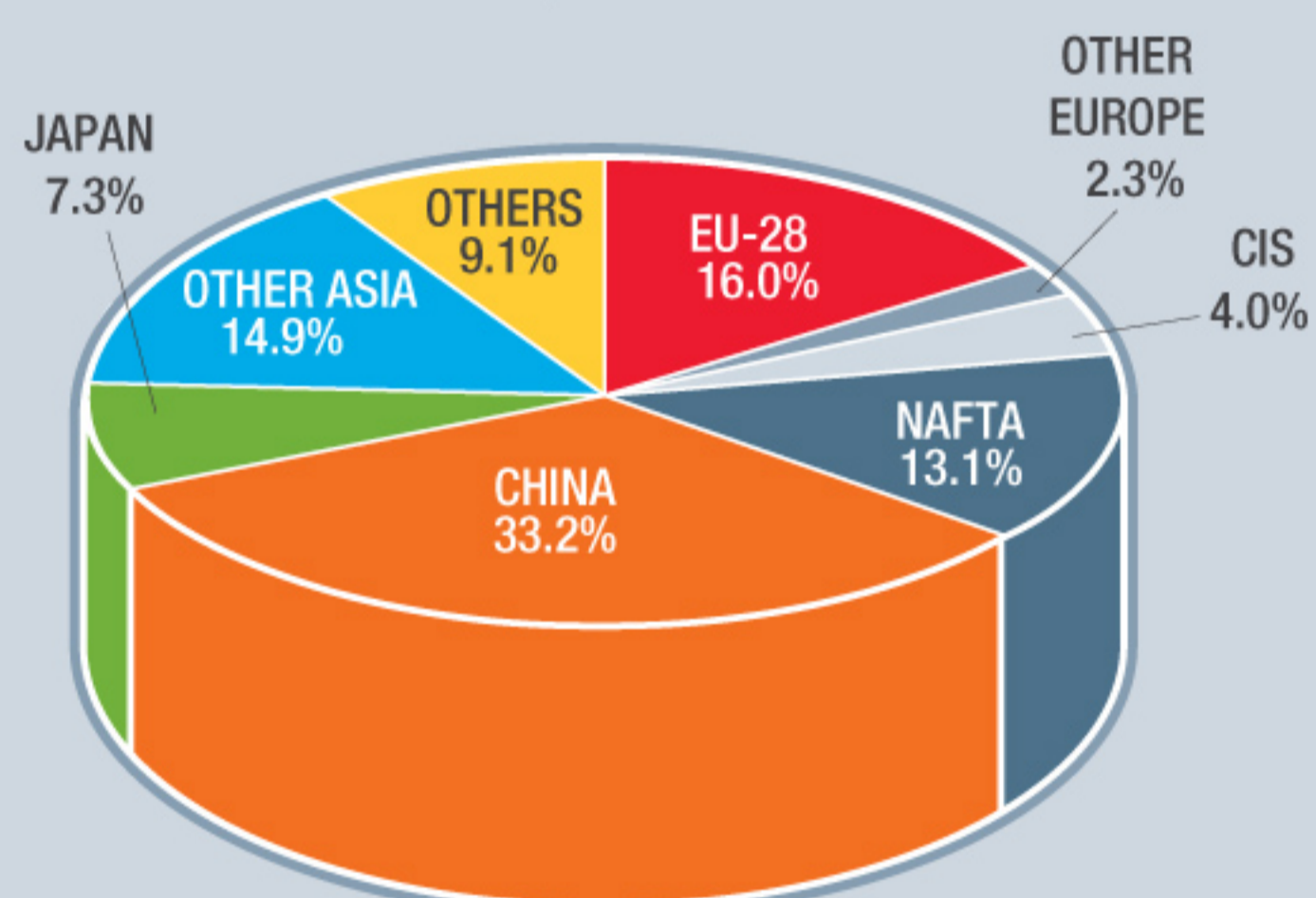

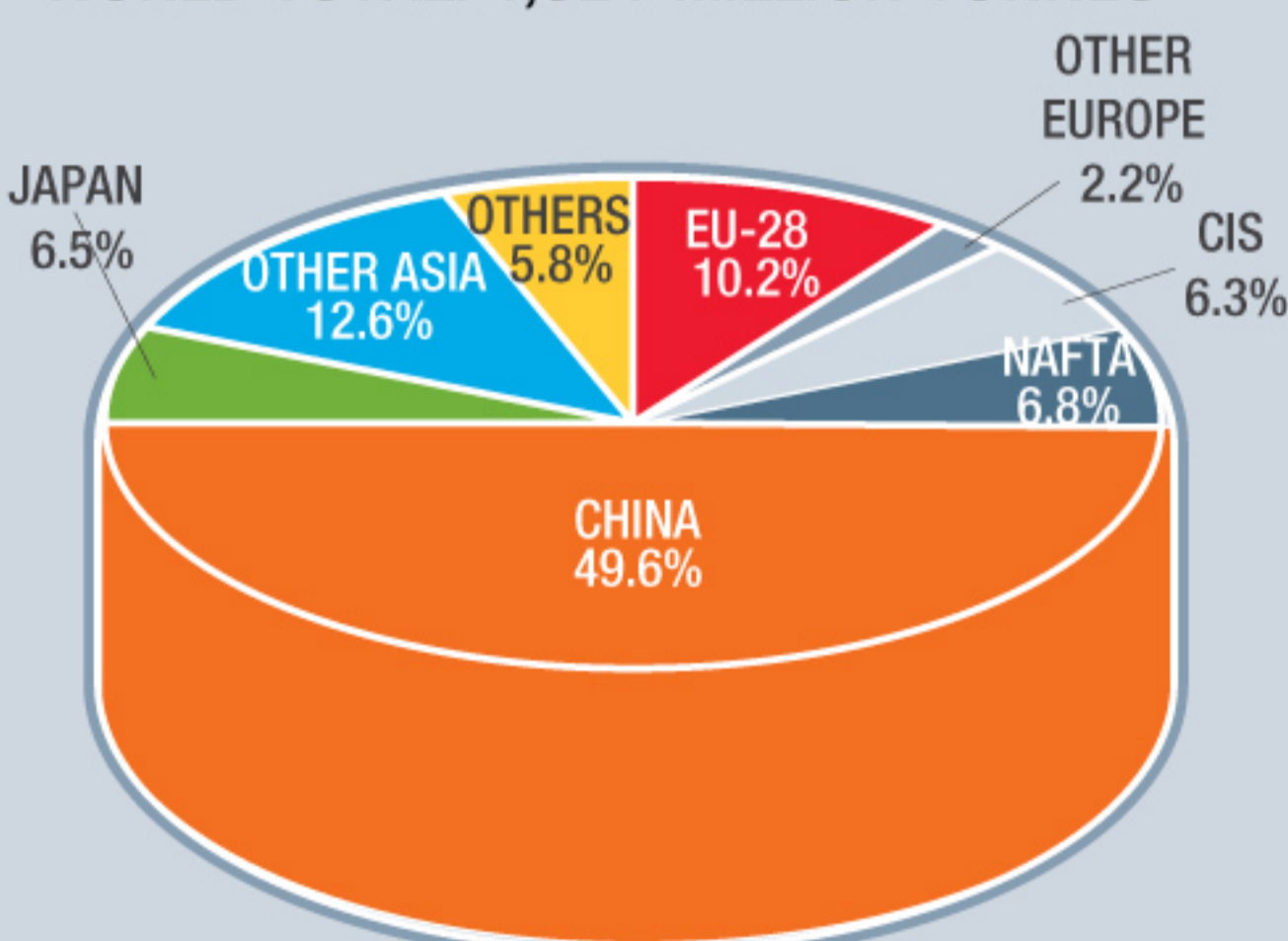

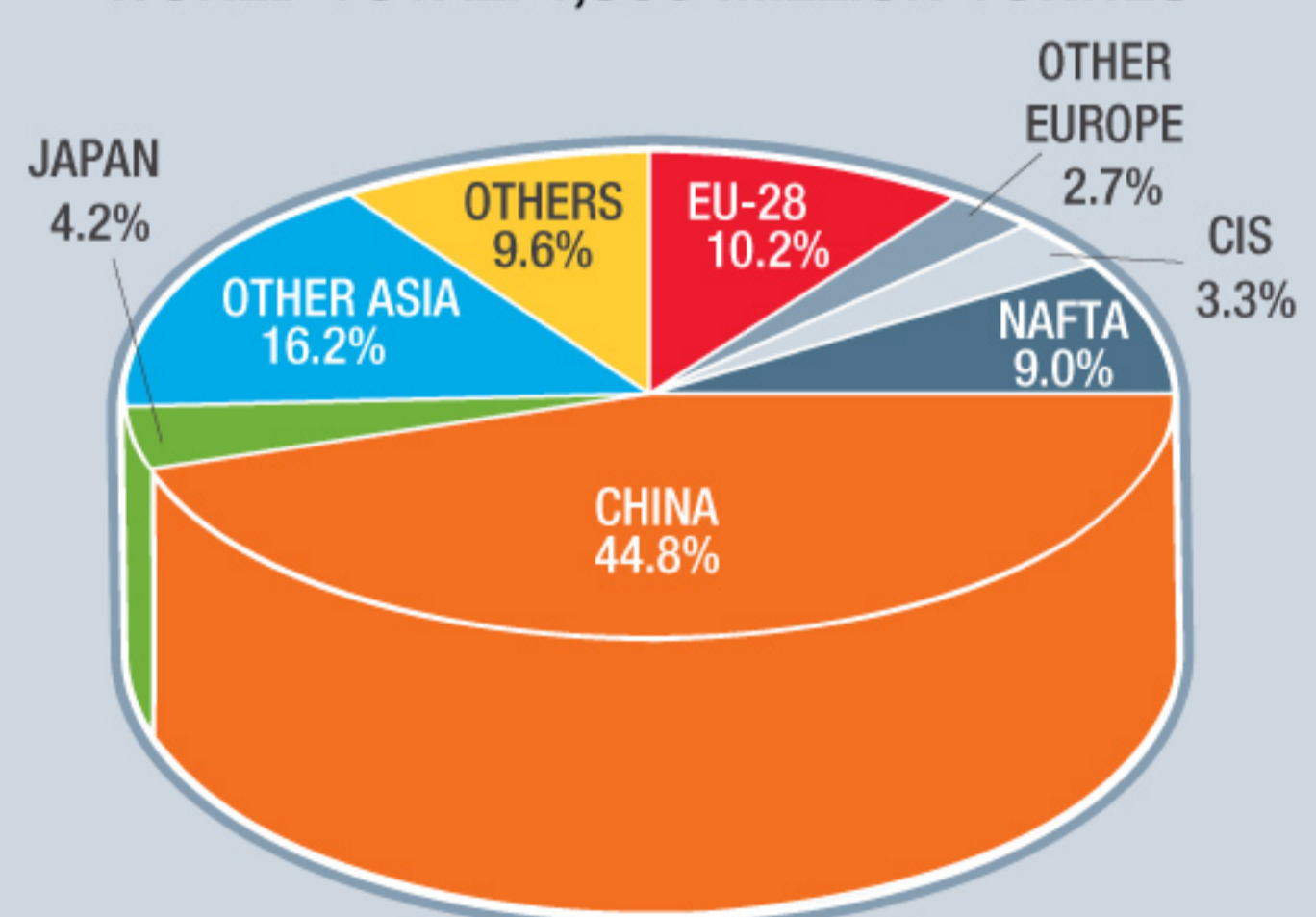
